She was informed that crossing guards are handled through the Tuckerton Police Dept. Mrs. Susan Marshall, the mayor was recognized, to discuss the matter. For the future, the parking lot is a huge project, of which many discussions have taken place by the Roads and Grounds Committee. Hopefully, a project for next summer, as it is clear we have a parking problem.
